**COVID Operating Procedures for EstateDanza 2021 (Continued)**

- Students, accompanists and faculty will only be allowed to participate in the program if there are no signs or symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days (**fever, cough, chills, sore throat, difficulty breathing, muscle pain, new loss of taste, new loss of smell**) and no close or sustained contact with anyone who is sick within 14 days of starting the intensive.
- Daily temperature check of COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival (before going onto the stage), both recorded for each dancer, faculty, accompanist and staff member: Use of a no-touch thermometer and if the temperature is > than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit then the individual must go home and monitor symptoms and contact a physician.
- Students, accompanists, and/or faculty need to arrive in Toronto 2 weeks prior to start date: should be in quarantine for 14 days before coming to the studios
- We REQUIRE staff to wear masks at all times and we REQUIRE students to wear masks before and after class and while on breaks. We STRONGLY RECOMMEND that students wear masks during class.
- Social distancing measures in place. 2 meters apart on stage during class (dance floor will be taped to provide 2 meters apart guidelines) and breaks
- No hands-on adjustments by faculty or instruct activities that require direct contact with another dancer
- There will be no physical contact between the dancers
- Hand sanitizers will be available everyday
- Make sure to effectively wash your hands and avoid touching of the face
- Cover your cough or sneeze into a tissue. Immediately throw the tissue in the garbage and wash hands/sanitize. If you do not have a tissue, sneeze or cough into your sleeve or arm.
- Limiting class sizes
- Limited teachers on staff
- Wearing a face covering/mask during classes is not mandatory
- Sanitize your hands before going on stage, after use of barres, touching dance floor or face/body and leaving the stage
- Enhanced cleaning procedures of the dance floor and barres, before class, in between classes and at the end of the day
- Wiping down the barres after use and cleaning the floors in between the classes: there will be a 30 minute break in between each class to allow for cleaning and fresh air circulation
- Bring changes of clothes to avoid the spread of sweat on the stage and contact with skin and a change of clothes to put on before traveling home
- Increase the awareness of COVID with signage to reinforce social distancing, guide traffic flow, and hygiene
- Limit the exposure outside the dance intensive (the number of social gatherings during the weeknights)
- **Please monitor your temperature and overall health on a daily basis. Stay at home if any COVID-19 symptoms arise.**

**About the Facility:**

**The Bandshell Stage has been cleaned and organized for all social distancing standards:**

- ProArteDanza will have exclusive use of the Bandshell Stage from 8:30am to 8:30pm- Monday to Friday
- The program is happening in an outdoor venue, therefore there is fresh air circulating daily
- There is a parking lot in front of the stage that allows for drop-off & pick-up (parents are allowed to observe the classes, if they remain in their vehicles or maintain social distancing)
- Floors are taped off and sectioned to allow individual dancing space for each dancer
- Hand sanitizer, face masks, and gloves will be provided throughout every day of the dance intensive
- Cleaning will be continuous throughout each day of the dance floor and barres
- Extra cleaning protocols will be in place before each day begins and at the end of each day, for the cleaning of the dance floor and barres
- Public washrooms will be available for use for participants in program and will be cleaned by unionized workers
- All social distancing guidelines will be followed

**If there are any signs of symptoms during EstateDanza, you will be sent home. If a faculty member has had COVID-19, then they need a clearance note from their doctor to teach during the program.**
